11:42	Definition of Lack: deficiency, shortage, scarcity.
12:30	If there wasn't a lack and you were walking around as if there were a lack, would you want to know?
16:09	Hosea 4:6 – My people are destroyed for a lack of knowledge.
17:42	Destroy (in the Hebrew): damah to be cut off or undone "my people are cut off or undone because they lack knowledge
19:55	God has a supply and he does not want us to be cut off from it. (not talking about money!) Grace, mercy, blessings, love, encouragement, forgiveness...
21:20	Banking Terms The word for this teaching is "reconciliation" Reconciling your back account Have you ever spent hours trying to reconciling your checking account? Have you ever spent hours reconciling your accounts with God so that we could look at things the way God looks at things?
25:10	Your bank doesn't care what you "feel" is in your account only what is actually there. You shouldn't walk in what you feel is in the bank but what's actually there.
26:00	You shouldn't walk in what you "feel" God has said only walk in what he reconciled to be true.
27:50	The path: Step One: God says one thing about you Step Two: You walk around behaving differently you Step Three: You have a lack of knowledge therefore: Step Four: You are cut off and undone Step Five: This affects your confidence and your courage Result: FEAR
30:11	What's in your spiritual bank account from God to you? The only way you will know is if you reconcile what he said.
31:00	1 John 1:9 – "If we confess our sins he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and cleanse us from all unrighteousness." What's my part? Confess my sins.
33:50	Exodus 34:7 – Keeping mercies for thousands
34:06	Ps. 103:12—as far as the east is from the west so has he removed our transgressions from us
34:22	Eph. 1:7 – in him we have redemption through his blood the forgiveness of sins according to the riches of his grace.
35:44	Romans 6:11 – Likewise you also reckon yourselves to be dead to sin and alive to God.
37:40	Reckon (Greek) logizomia to count, to compute, to calculate, to impute, suppose, deem, judge, determine, purpose, decide. This has to do with what is real. This has to do more with fact than supposition or opinion
41:20	"Likewise" refers to Romans 4 – Logizomia is used 11 times in this chapter about Abraham
