1:15	Opening Prayer
2:15	Review
4:40	Romans 8:14 - 18    "for as many as are led by the Spirit of God, these are the songs of God/ for you did not receive the spirit of bondage again to fear, but you receive the Spirit of adoptions by whom we cry out, "Abba, Father." The Spirit Himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God and if children, then heirs – heirs of God and joint heirs with Christ, if indeed we suffer with Him, that we may also be glorified together."
7:30	"Joint heirs with Christ" example of a joint checking account.
8:50	"If indeed..." the only way we can have the inheritance is if we have suffered with him.
9:25	"If indeed..." = I'm willing to live my life the way God wants not how I want. Jesus said, "not my will but yours be done."
10:48	When you bow your knee to God (attitude of the heart) and you suffer because of it: that's suffering with Christ.
11:36	There is great cost: being a Christ follower you will suffer.
13:42	Ps. 107:14 – "Fools because of their transgressions (missed the mark) and because of their iniquities (bend the truth) they are afflicted (reaping and sow). Their soul abhorred all manner of fools and drew close to death. They cried out to the Lord in their trouble and he saved them out of their destructions."
16:46	The fool cried out and God saved the fool!
17:50	Luke 15 – the Prodigal Son
20:20	Who did the running? God ran to the fool after the fool came to his senses.
21:00	"Quick! Bring out the best robe..."
23:05	Restoring the fool was in God's heart all along
23:20	Bless – What were we originally created for? God released Adam and Eve to be prosperous.
26:10	John's testimony of when he first met his biological father.
36:15	"Glorified Together" (Romans 14:17) this is the only time it shows up in scripture. It means to exalt to a state of dignity and happiness in the company of another.
